

CANINE FUNTIME DOG PARK RULES

- Dogs are the only animals allowed in the dog parks. Cats are permitted for grooming services only and are required to be caged while entering or exiting the facility.
- Dogs must be on leash when entering and exiting any area of the facility except in the dog parks.
- Dogs must be healthy and free from contagious disease, fleas, ticks and be current on all vaccinations.
- All customers bringing a dog into the dog park must check in upon entering and check out upon exiting.
- Dogs must be in sight of their handler or owner and within voice control while in the dog park.
- **Upon entering the facility all dogs must visit the canine grass area.**
- Prior to entering the park, choker chains and spiked collars must be removed from all dogs.
- All dogs must wear a collar in the dog park and be approved by Canine Funtime. Dog owners and handlers must have a leash for each dog they are in control of while in the park.
- **All dog owners and handlers are responsible for the clean up and disposal of their dogs waste.**
- Dogs in heat are prohibited from using the dog park.
- Owners and handlers of a dog showing any signs of aggression must be leashed immediately and removed from other dogs and from the dog park. Non-compliance will result in the removal of the dog from the dog park or facility by staff and is at the sole discretion of Canine Funtime staff.
- All dogs under six (6) months of age are prohibited from the dog park for their own safety.
- A limit of two (2) dogs per adult owner or handler is enforced within the dog park. Any owner or handler must be sixteen (16) years of age or older while in the dog park. Any owner or handler under the age of (18) shall only be in the control of one dog at a time and must demonstrate to staff the ability to have proper control of the dog.
- Glass containers, food bowls, dog chews and human food are prohibited from the dog park. No food Canine or Human is to be brought into Canine Funtime, with the exception of water to be used for dog water bowls. Bite size training treats and dog food is prohibited.
- Smoking is prohibited within the dog park and Canine Funtime facility.
- Customers are prohibited from bringing chairs or lounges into the dog park. However, wheelchairs motorized and non-motorized are allowed in the dog park providing, the use is not directly resulting in damage to the specialty flooring used in the dog park.
- Shoes with heels, or with pointed soles are not allowed in the dog park, to protect the dog park flooring. **A flat sole shoe is required within the park. A sandal or open toe shoe is not permitted while in the dog park.** A shoe similar to a sneaker is best suited and the recommended foot wear for use in the dog park.
- **Owners and handlers must immediately respond to any request to control their dogs.**
- Play toys or chew toys are not allowed in the dog park. Balls and throw toys are allowed in the dog park providing the toy is an approved toy to be used in the park by Canine Funtime. At the sole discretion of Canine Funtime staff, the use of balls and throw toys can be immediately stopped if the toy is creating an aggression situation between dogs, or for any reason.
- **Children must be supervised by an adult while in the park and within arms reached at all times. Children must never carry toys or any food while in the dog park.**
